Annemarie Nussbaumer (1976) studied law at the Universities of Bern and Heidelberg and was subsequently admitted to the bar in Bern. From 2022, Annemarie Nussbaumer was Head of Supervision of Small Banks and Securities Firms, after leading the Authorisation section within the Banks division from 2019 to 2022. Between 2016 and 2019, she held the position of Head of International Cooperation at FINMA. Annemarie Nussbaumer joined FINMA in 2012, where she was initially responsible in the Enforcement division for enforcing the duty to disclose shareholdings in listed companies and appeals against Takeover Board rulings. Prior to that, she worked as a research assistant at the University of Zurich and as a lawyer for several years.
