Jan Blöchli (1977) completed his legal studies at the University of St. Gallen in 2002 and passed the bar examination in Canton Zurich in 2005. He went on to do an LL.M. in Securities and Financial Regulation at Georgetown University Law Center in the US.

He began his professional career as an attorney-at-law at various corporate law firms. He joined FINMA in 2011, taking on central legal functions. In 2013, he became General Secretary and was made Head of General Secretariat and Communications. He then went on to lead the Supervision of Credit Suisse Group from 2015 to 2018 and was responsible for prudential and conduct supervision, including coordinating and cooperating with foreign supervisory authorities which supervise subsidiaries and branches of global banking group.

As of 16 July 2018, Jan Blöchli heads the Banks division and is subsequently a member of FINMA's Executive Board.
